

In accordance with the requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act, the United States Air Force, in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration, has released the Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed White Elk Military Operations Area (MOA). The proposed MOA would underlie existing training airspace at the western edge of the Utah Test and Training Range (UTTR) to create additional special use airspace in northeastern Nevada. Use of chaff and flares in the MOA and Air Traffic Control Assigned Airspace (ATCAA) would be permitted as well as authorization for supersonic flight above 18,000 feet mean sea level (MSL). If approved, the White Elk MOA would provide training opportunities for F-16 pilots not consistently available in the existing UTTR airspace.
